REMINDER
CHILD EYE AND DENTAL EXAM
DUE DATE

January 5, 2014

Kentucky law, KRS 156.160(i), requires proof of a dental screening or examination by a dentist, dental hygienist, physician, registered nurse, advanced registered nurse practitioner, or physician assistant. It also requires proof of a vision examination by an optometrist or ophthalmologist. This evidence shall be presented to the school no later than January 1 of the first year that a five (5) or six (6) year old is enrolled in a Kentucky public school for the first time.
