

# COVID-19 Quarantine Flowchart

January 2022



This Powerpoint is a flowchart to help you determine the protocol for quarantining and masking after testing positive for COVID-19 or after your exposure to a positive COVID-19 case.

## PLEASE NOTE:

1. Anyone who has been contact-traced or tests positive may choose to extend their quarantine to 10 days instead of 5 days where applicable.
2. All masking requirements in this document apply ONLY when we are “mask optional”.
3. If you choose to have a PCR or rapid COVID-19 test on day 5 of your quarantine/exposure, and the test is negative, masking will be optional upon receiving your results. We will accept tests from the health department, doctor’s office, pharmacy, or other health official.
4. As of January 2022, “fully vaccinated” is defined by the CDC and local health department as:
  - a. Received both doses of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine within the last 6 months.
  - b. Received both doses of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine AND a booster dose.
  - c. Received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine within the last 2 months.
  - d. Received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine AND a booster dose.

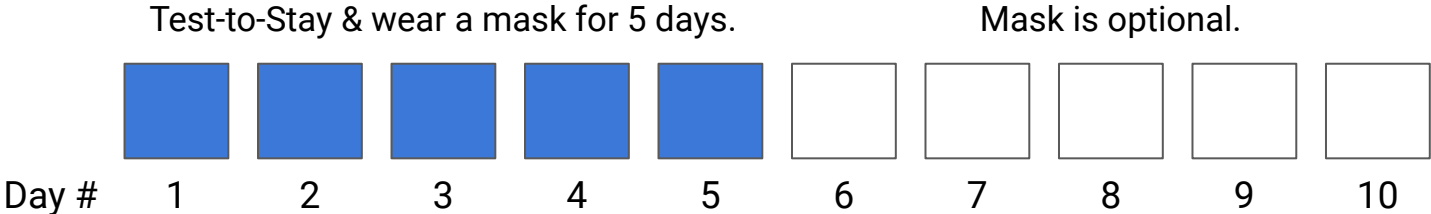


# I am not fully vaccinated and I was exposed to COVID-19 **at school**.

\*K-5 students will not have to quarantine for school exposures, but will be required to wear a mask for 10 days.

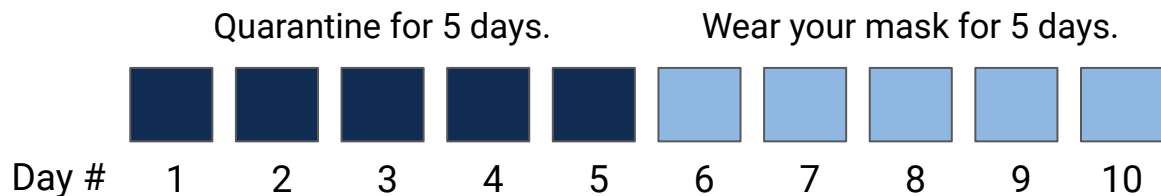

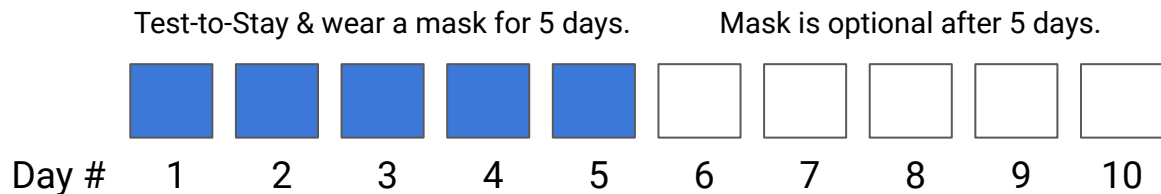


Start Over

I am not fully vaccinated and I was exposed to COVID-19 **at home**.

\*Day 1 starts the day after the LAST day of your contact with the positive case OR the day after the last day of the positive case's quarantine.

Ex. Parent tests positive but cannot isolate. Children must quarantine or Test-to-Stay while in contact with parent PLUS 5 days.

Ex. Parent tests positive, but isolates using a separate bedroom and bathroom. Children quarantine or Test-to-Stay 5 days after that parent goes into isolation.
